In 1975 he obtained his Master's Degrees in Law (*premio extraordinario*) and in Classical Studies at the University of Barcelona. In 1977 he joined the Bar Association. In 1989 he was appointed Judge. In 1997 he was elected Chief Judge (*Decano*) by the 176 Judges of the Bench of Barcelona and re-elected in 2001. In January 2004 he was appointed Deputy European Data Protection Supervisor and since then too he is judge at the Court of Appeal in Barcelona (on leave for international public functions). He has been active as expert of the Council of Europe in programs relating to the judiciary for Central and Eastern European countries from 1989 to 2003.
