

Lorna Woods is a professor in the Department of Law and Director of the LLM in Information Technology, Media and e-Commerce, as well as member of the Human Rights Centre, at the University of Essex. After working as a solicitor in the City of London, she moved to academia where she specialised in European law and, building on her experience in practice, media regulation. She has written extensively in the area of media law and freedom of expression and has recently co-authored a book on European Broadcasting Law and Policy (Cambridge University Press). She has also been involved in a number of studies relating to this area and is currently part of a team commissioned by the European Commission to investigate self and co-regulation of the Internet.
