This publication contains the texts of the speeches and papers which have been presented at the Symposium on Copyright Administrative Institutions , which took place in Montreal in 2001 under the auspices of the Centre de Recherche en droit public (CRDP) of the University of Montreal.

The workings of the Copyright Board of Canada, which has an increasing role in the implementation of collective management of copyright in Canada, have been examined extensively at the Symposium. The event has also provided a meeting for a comparative overview of administrative institutions in the copyright field in a number of countries, among them Australia, Germany, Poland and the United States of America, presented by national copyright experts. Further to that, the publication includes a report on that study prepared by C. Kusy, which is one of the first attempts for a systematic analysis of those institutions and an useful contribution to the examination of this aspect of copyright law.
